2017 Involuntary Commitment



Involuntary Commitment is a project from the winemaking team at Andrew Will Winery. They use only fruit from sources vetted by Will and Chris.

This wine shows the same drinkability as the 2016 vintage but with more breadth due to the majority of Cabernet Sauvignon. On the palate, it exhibits layers of violets, blueberries and herbal notes with silky tannins and plenty of mouthfeel. It is a wine that will drink great in a glass now while also maintaining excellent aging capabilities. 2017 started out with a cool spring but caught up to typically ripening levels in august. A cooler second half to September allowed delayed hang times and wines that show excellent ripeness while maintaining finesse and structure.
